

Download 12 7 As A Mixed Fraction

In a fraction, the number of equal parts being described is the numerator (from Latin numerator, "counter" or "numberer"), and the type or variety of the parts is the denominator (from Latin denominator, "thing that names or designates"). As an example, the fraction $\frac{8}{5}$ amounts to eight parts, each of which is of the type named "fifth". In terms of division, the numerator corresponds to the number of parts, and the denominator corresponds to the number of parts in one whole. 1. Rename Mixed to Fractions with Circles Name _____ .
