Besides surgery and drug treatment, other ways of ablating body ... The disorder now known as Noonan syndrome bears similarities to the disorder described by Turner (1938) and shown by Ford et al. (1959) to have its basis in a 45,X chromosomal aberration called Turner syndrome, Ullrich-Turner syndrome (Wiedemann and Glatzl, 1991), or monosomy X. .
