Mazo de la Roche (January 15, 1879 – July 12, 1961), born Mazo Louise Roche in Newmarket, Ontario, Canada, was the author of the Jalna novels, one of the most popular series of books of her time. Mazo de la Roche was a Canadian bestselling author of literature and fiction novels famously known as the author of Whiteoaks of Jalna Saga which debuted in 1927 concluding Morning At Jalna in 1960. Mazo was the only child of Alberta Roche the great-great-niece of David Wilson and William Roche, a salesman. Mazo de la Roche leaped to prominence as one of the most successful writers of the 20th century when the first novel in her Whiteoaks of Jalna series won the Atlantic Monthly prize in 1927. The award was hailed not only as a triumph for de la Roche but as marking the coming of age of Canadian literature.
